Call for research proposals for All Academic Staff in FY2019

In FY2010, the IAMU launched a research project system (supported by The Nippon Foundation) to bring about further progress in capacity building among the IAMU member universities. This research project system will continue in FY2019 through a new research project system. The IAMU Research Project system is divided into two frameworks, one for All Academic Staff and the other for Young Academic Staff.

Taking into account the contents of the annual report prepared by the Liaison Committee, the working group on research projects established under the Academic Affairs Committee has selected the following 2 themes for research proposals in FY2019, which are for all academic staff at the IAMU member universities:

- Theme 1- Impact of new concepts on Maritime Education and Training; and
- Theme 2- Innovative technology for improvement of routine ship operations.

Another theme proposed by a member university might also be welcome as Theme 3, if it is reasonably related with IAMU's objectives and goals.

Those who are interested in submitting a research proposal for one of the themes above should visit the IAMU website (<http://www.iamu-edu.org/>) to download the application forms, and

- (1) Prepare a research proposal taking into account possible concepts, desired goals for each theme and the maximum amount of budget allocated to each theme as shown in the Annex 1 to this paper, and
- (2) Submit the application forms by e-mail with a subject "RP2019 Theme X" to the IAMU Secretariat shown below by midnight, 31 May 2018 JST (Japan Standard Time). Annex 2 and 3 will give you detailed procedures for your application.
