It is our great pleasure to announce "International Conference on the history of Maritime Technology", which will be co-organised by Tokyo University of Marine Science and Technology, Faculty of Marine Technology and Piri Reis University, with cooperation of Research Salon for History of Maritime Technology in Japan and Maritime History Research Center of Piri Reis University.

Our aim is to open new horizons by studying the maritime technology background in the history, looking into the various areas related with the accident analysis, maritime forensic matters, history of maritime navigation and ship building, and other miscellaneous subjects like submarine, construction history etc. Thus enabling researchers, engineers, technical historians to ponder in deep and improve new maritime technologies in the future.

The key note speeches will be delivered by Prof. İsmail Hakkı Helvacıoğlu and Japanese expert who are well known maritime figures in their areas. The language of conference is in English and 20 minutes of presentation time is allocated to presenters whereas 30 minutes to key note speakers.

Researchers wishing to participate in the conference are kindly requested to submit their abstracts to the conference secretary, Dr. Akram Nejabati (anejabati@pirireis.edu.tr) as scheduled below. Abstracts should be in English, maximum 400 words and 5 keywords. All abstracts will be evaluated by the scientific committee and the list of participants and the programme of conference will be promulgated not later than 1st April 2024. In considering the upcoming abstracts, priority will be given to unknown and unpublished studies based on original documents.

The Proceedings of the conference will be prepared as well, either digital or hard copy. Full texts of the articles to be included in the proceedings, should be delivered to the conference secretary, preferably in doc./docx. format and should not exceed 15 pages. The scientific committee has right to select the articles to be included in the proceedings.
