Call for research proposals for Young Academic Staff in FY2022

A research project system for Young Academic Staff was launched in FY2018. The main purpose of this new Research Project System is to encourage young academic staff to participate in the IAMU activities.

Taking the contents of the annual report prepared by the Liaison Committee into account, the working group on research projects established under the Academic Affairs Committee has selected the following 3 themes for research proposals in FY2022, which are for young academic staff at the IAMU member universities:

- Theme 1- The prospective role of Maritime Education and Training
- Theme 2- Maritime transport for sustainable development
- Theme 3- Optional (Related to IAMU goals and objectives)

Those who are interested in submitting a research proposal for Young Academic Staff should visit the IAMU website (<http://www.iamu-edu.org/>) to download the application forms, and

- (1) Prepare the research proposal taking into account the maximum amount of budget USD 20,000, and
- (2) Submit the forms by e-mail with a subject "RP2021 YAS" to the IAMU Secretariat shown below by midnight, 31 May 2021 JST (Japan Standard Time). Annex 1, 2 and 3 will give you the detailed procedure for your application.
